What Placing Looks Like

Judge will do the following:

Place each class individually

Then go back through and pick the top 10-12 overall projects

Live Premium Sale

Top 6 overall make sale

Tent Sale

Set prices for each category

Tent Sale Prices

The top 6 arrangements will sell at the premium sale on stage.

The remainder of the students will choose 1 (ONE) arrangement to sell, and the arrangements will be priced depending upon the category they are in (see below for prices). This allows buyers the right to purchase. The student will receive ALL of this money to help cover some of the costs of their arrangement and supplies. The student is NOT required to put their item in the sale.

Procedures:

- Write the student's name, arrangement type, and price on cardstock and place with the arrangement on the table. The student is not required to sell, this is optional. They may take their arrangement home if they don't make the premium sale.
- The buyer takes the arrangement tag and arrangement to the cashier and pays for the item.
- 3. Record the students name and TOTAL amount.
- Checks will be cut after all funds have been cleared. They will be mailed to the individual.
